

Prayer Activity Two


Draw your favorite things <u>then</u> tell God what they are. We are best friends with God when we talk to Him.




Indoor/Outdoor Sound Hunt: God loves it when we listen to Him. Let's find things that He has created that makes these sounds.

Thank God for the happiness I feel


